Please note: Many fields on this sample form will not work. This is just to give you an idea of what information you will need to prepare in order to complete the application online. Try to complete the online form in one sitting, but you may if necessary save your work for up to 7 days.

<u>Important</u>: If not the applicant, the actual PRODUCER of the show must be listed in personnel. This is the Person or Company who is financially responsible for the show, who engages the necessary artists, and with whom we actually contract. For staged works, a Stage Manager is required but need not be listed now.

Online, many text boxes will expand to fit the content you type in. And there will always be room to provide full address links (URL) to work samples or resumes you wish us to see. You may also directly "attach" documents to your submission (only as DOC, RTF, or PDF files), but photos and very large files are better as links. You may use Dropbox, or Google Docs, or any such online file server. Vimeo or YouTube or other services may be used for links to video files.

Most text boxes online also have "help" features - little question marks - that expand to give helpful hints about information needed.

If accepted, you may be asked to submit a "marketing plan" of how you expect to market your show, along with a rough production budget. We do not use your budget figures to make judgments about your show; this is merely to assure us you are on the road to successful production planning. We are here to help, and we have twelve years of Festival data to draw upon. Ask for advice anytime.

If you are an "Out of town" production - that is, applying from outside a 25 mile radius of New York City - you will be asked to engage a local New York City publicist. We will provide a list of people and companies who know the local market, along with their usual price ranges.

For **Visual Art**: Submissions are not yet accepted via this application process. Please Email us in early-November for next year's theme and submission process.

For **Musical/Opera/Cabaret**: Please submit a link to audio recording of select musical numbers and a copy of the book (.pdf or .doc format only), or submit a video link (Vimeo or Youtube) to the complete work.
